MATCHING FUNDS: MULTIPLYING IMPACT

Why the Matching Fund Program Matters

At the Community Foundation of Ogden Valley, our Matching Fund Program is designed to amplify generosity and strengthen collaboration across the Valley.

Rather than asking nonprofits to fundraise alone, CFOV brings donors and organizations together—leveraging donor dollars to support 16 local nonprofit organizations working to improve life in Ogden Valley.

How It Works

- Donor contributions are pooled into a matching fund
- Local nonprofits raise funds for their own missions
- CFOV matches those funds, up to \$5,000 in 2025, multiplying the impact of donations
- Organizations receive increased support while donors see their giving go further

We match funds to multiply what organizations are raising on their own—turning individual generosity into collective impact.

The Matching Fund Program does more than increase dollars raised—it creates a spirit of collaboration among nonprofit organizations.



The Big Give

Each year, this collaborative effort comes to life during The Big Give, a community-wide celebration of generosity that brings donors and nonprofits together in a powerful, visible way.

GRANT PROGRAM



Thanks to the incredible generosity of Powder Mountain and the proceeds from their Timberline Chairlift auction, the Community Foundation of Ogden Valley proudly awarded more than \$75,000 in our first-ever CFOV Grants in September 2025.

This grant fund was created to support special projects that enrich life in our community—and on September 23, 2025, that vision became a reality. We are honored to recognize the local nonprofit organizations whose impactful projects were funded this year.

2025 CFOV GRANT RECIPIENTS:

Valley Elementary PTO – \$5,875

Funding for shade structures for all three playgrounds at Valley Elementary School.

Eden Valley Trails – \$5,325.73

Support for a utility trailer to transport trail-building equipment.

Scouting America (Crossroads of the West Scouting Council) – \$9,000

Improvements to roads and parking at Camp Kiesel & Camp Browning, serving more than 8,000 youth annually.

Ogden Valley Adaptive Sports – \$8,500

Funding for a state-of-the-art sit ski to expand adaptive recreation opportunities.

Mountain Arts & Music – \$3,394

Support for community arts and music programs.

Ogden Avalanche – \$7,500

Installation of a free public avalanche beacon training facility at North Fork Park.

Ogden Nordic – \$9,219

Parts and electrical components to repair and maintain a 2018 snow cat used for trail grooming.

Back Country Horsemen – \$10,000

Upgrades and expansion of corrals at North Fork Park.

Ogden Valley Tennis & Pickleball – \$10,000

Installation of lighting for pickleball courts.

Ogden Valley Recreation – \$5,360

Development of a new comprehensive recreation website.
